Easter Day 2018

He is not here; he has risen!

Luke 24:1-6a

I don't know how many of you noticed the sign out the front on the way in....

We've kept it under wraps but can **finally** share with you that we've sold the church (here) at Sunshine Beach.... (*Photo with 'sold' sign*)

And the date?

1st April!! /////

"He is not here; he has risen!" – announced the messenger to the scared and frightened, grieving women who came to the tomb early in the morning....

He is not here, he has risen!

Let me ask you – this claim that Jesus rose from the dead – it is **hoax** or **history**?

it's a good question to ask on April fools' day!

Because it's **completely** possible that in the whole Jesus-rising-from-the-dead story, we've <u>all</u> been Aprilfooled... totally **hoodwinked**!

I'm sure you've got some fabulous April fools' stories to tell – either where you've **planned** a brilliant prank, or been the **victim** of a brilliant prank...

How's **this** for a prank? // (*run video*) – it's the story of the Swiss Spaghetti harvest – when the respected BBC show *Panorama* announced on 1st April, 1957, that thanks to a mild winter, Swiss farmers were enjoying a **bumper spaghetti** crop... here they are – pulling **spaghetti** down from the **trees**... viewers were calling the BBC wanting to know how they could grow their **own spaghetti tree**!! //

People are easily fooled... //

Are we among them? /

Was the resurrection of Jesus a fabrication? – to keep the myth alive that Jesus was God?

Was the **resurrection** of Jesus merely the product of a creative <u>imagination</u>? – by the disciples who wanted to hope against hope that he wasn't really gone?

Or was it an <u>hallucination</u> of the masses – grief stricken that their whole world had been turned upside **down**... and they 'saw' Jesus in their mind's eye... and were convinced?

Fabrication? Imagination? Hallucination?

He is not here! He has risen.

Hoax or history?

Two things (at least!) are required for this to be history

1. No body

The consistent evidence from eye witnesses was of an **empty tomb** and **no body**.

The women who went on Sunday morning said there was **no body**

Peter and John who went to check out their bizarre story... saw **no body**...

And no authorities ever came up with the body to put the claim to bed

It's **true** someone may have **stolen** the body...

...but the tomb was **guarded** by elite **Roman soldiers**

...the Jews had no reason to steal the body and every incentive to come up with it

...the Romans had no reason to steal the body because they wanted all this Jesus fuss to go away

...and the **disciples** were **broken** and **grieving** and **confused** and **scared**... locking themselves away in a room thinking they'd be killed next... it's **unthinkable** that they would steal the body and then be prepared to be **killed** for the **lie**!

There was an **empty tomb** and **no body**... //

Second – if Jesus was raised to life, Jesus needed to have been:

2. Seen alive!

And there were **many** reports that Jesus was seen alive...

On one occasion by more than 500 people at a time...

...it wasn't **concocted**... the author of that report published within **30** years of the event – and actually says in his report – go and ask those who are still alive and saw him... some have died he says – most are still **around**...! "Check out my story," he challenged!

If I wrote up a report of a certain ball tampering in Cape Town 30 years from now, saying it <u>never</u> <u>happened</u>...

....how long do you think it would take for my report to be **discredited** and then never see the light of day **again**?

Those who were **there** and **saw** it, would **immediately discount** it.

And if a report was written within <u>30</u> years of Jesus being around that said 500 people saw Jesus alive and no one actually **did**...? **That** report would never have seen the **light** of **day**....!

There was /

No **body**

There were

Plenty of people who reported seeing Jesus' alive! //

I'm not an historian... but here is what I understand about how historians view this...

They say that they cannot **prove** whether or not Jesus rose from the **dead**...

They can only explore why it was widely **reported** that Jesus was seen again...

When they explore **all** the possibilities about **why** it was **reported** that Jesus was seen **alive**... they say that the **clearest** and most plausible **explanation** as it why people were reporting that Jesus was seen **alive**... is because he **WAS** in fact – seen <u>alive</u>!!

He is not here. He has risen. ///

But so what?

So let me finish with these two questions

- 1. What if it's **HOAX**?
- 2. What if it is HISTORY?

HOAX?

If it's a **hoax**, then the whole of Christianity falls apart.

If Jesus didn't rise from the dead – if someone comes up with the body... then <u>nothing</u> about the Christian faith survives.

All the Old Testament prophecies are false

We have no clue who Jesus is

Jesus was a liar or he was mad

And if he hasn't therefore come from God – if he wasn't God turned up in human flesh – we have no idea whether God even exists!

If Jesus' resurrection was a hoax? - then we all walk away

Close up the churches

Shut down the charities

Put away your Bibles

Stop fooling yourself that God is real,

that he cares,
that serving him is real,
that prayer makes a difference,
that there will be justice in the end or
that there is a life to come! //

If Jesus didn't rise, none of it is true, none of it matters, none of it is relevant. Walk away!

What it if it is **HISTORY**?

Then like our Easter advertising this year has said – this is one weekend in history that changed the world **forever**. //

Changed the world forever? Yes, because there's **justice**, there are **answers**, there is **hope** and we have a **future**.

Changed the world forever? Yes, because we can be confident not only about the existence of God, but the presence of God in our world and in our lives – and also the power of God, the love of God, the justice of God and the mercy of God.

Changed the world forever? Yes, because now we **know** that there is a world **beyond this** where all **wrongs** will be put **right**, and we'll live in **perfect relationship** with **God**

It it's true, then it matters... it's significant...

If it's **true**, then there is **nothing else more important** in this world then **welcoming** and **embracing** the God who loves you **so much** that he gave his Son to **die** and **rise again** so that you can be **forgiven** and have **eternal life.** //

Let me finish with a question... if Jesus rose from the dead and changed the world forever, let me ask you – has he changed **your** world?

Changed your world because you've said 'sorry' for all you've mucked up and claimed his promised forgiveness?

Changed your world because he's daily shaping you and making you more like Jesus?

Changed your world because nothing matters more than living in the presence of and for the honour of the one who died and was raised for you?

April fool?

Hoax or history?

Hoax - none of it matters

<u>History</u> – it's the most important truth in the all the world – and needs to be the most **important** and **precious** and **wonderful** and **life-changing** truth in <u>YOUR</u> WORLD!
