- 3. v.12 How has the work of the Spirit in your life helped you to grow in understanding all that God has freely given?
- 4. v.13 How can we ensure that we are 'Spirit taught'? How are you using that teaching to explain spiritual realities to others?
- 5. What do you see are the differences exhibited in the world today between the 'spiritual person' and the 'unspiritual person'? Where do you need to confess unspiritual behaviour?
- 6. Do you ever find yourself listening to the world's wisdom even when you know God has said it is foolish?
- 7. As we conclude this series what has been a new insight or learning for you from these 2 chapters?
- 8. How are you planning to put this learning into practice?
