1. Share around the group either a funny or frustrating story of not knowing what another person was thinking.
2. v.10b How would you describe the Spirit's job of searching all things, even the deep things of God? How open are you to God's Spirit searching you?
3. v.12 How has the work of the Spirit in your life helped you to grow in understanding all that God has freely given?
4. v.13 How can we ensure that we are 'Spirit taught'? How are you using that teaching to explain spiritual realities to others?
5. What do you see are the differences exhibited in the world today between the 'spiritual person' and the 'unspiritual person'? Where do you need to confess unspiritual behaviour?
6. Do you ever find yourself listening to the world's wisdom even when you know God has said it is foolish?
7. As we conclude this series – what has been a new insight or learning for you from these 2 chapters?
8. How are you planning to put this learning into practice?
