Overall Purpose

Noosa Anglican is an evangelical church seeking to become more active in our community. This is a part time position, 2-3 days per week to be negotiated.

The Community Chaplain will be fully supportive of our vision, “Living to love and proclaim Jesus” and our values “Christ-centred, Bible-based, Spirit-led, Mission-shaped.”

Key Selection Criteria

- committed to Jesus, people and building community
- good interpersonal skills
- able to initiate and follow up new contacts
- ability to relate to and communicate with a diverse range of people
- able to work in a team context
- experience in pastoral care
- general computer skills - experience with Mac Office and Elvanto an advantage

Key Responsibilities

- build connections with the local community to offer support and care
- help initiate and lead community building opportunities within Noosa Anglican
- build bridges between Noosa Anglican and the wider community
- work alongside other pastoral staff and our Pastoral Care Teams to provide pastoral care in a coordinated way

Other Requirements

- flexibility in finding your place in the Noosa community and Anglican Church Noosa
- formal training in either theology or ministry (desired but not essential)
- current Driver's Licence and own reliable vehicle (a travelling allowance will be paid)
- current positive Blue Card notice for child related employment
